This course will introduce the beginner to the world of patchwork and quilting. Working through some traditional and non-traditional blocks, learners will gain in confidence to be able to design and make their own quilt or similar patchwork and quilted items. Improvers may want to perfect their skills for more precise results.

## About Your Tutor

Marion has interests in many forms of textiles including weaving and bobbin lace. She taught art and design technology for over 30 years and once retired concentrated on her own design work. Marion would describe herself as a 'Modern Quilter' where old designs are invigorated with contemporary fabrics. She exhibits her work every year through Cambridge Open Studios. Marion is an active member of Cambridge Quilters and often gives talks and runs workshops. With her art and design background, Marion feels confident she can bring out your creative side.

## Materials you will need:

- The Centre does have a couple of sewing machines available though using your own is the best option.
- A ¼" patchwork presser foot would be great if you have one.

## For the first session

- Bring any equipment you have such as a rotary cutter, mat and ruler, but only if you already have them.
- Any fabric scraps you have would be a bonus!

The tutor will provide rest of equipment to share with the group.
