For those who want to get started in creating their own silver jewellery designs, and for those who may have done some previous silver work and want to build on those silversmithing skills.

You will learn the principles of shaping and soldering silver to create jewellery and the practical side of designing your own pieces. And for those who have some experience, you will have help in learning further techniques to create your designs.

Tina has been a tutor here at Cottenham for some years now, bringing her considerable experience in silversmithing and making jewellery to a professional standard, and her experience of lecturing and passing on knowledge to a variety of age groups. What you need to bring to the first session

Wear old clothes, and flat shoes, and ensure long hair is tied back. A cloth apron, if you have one, is a good idea. Bring your own drink in a non-spill travel mug, or flask. If you wish to take notes, or do some preliminary designs, a notebook and pencil will be useful.

Anything you wish to keep is paid for by weight, according to the price of silver at the time.
