This course is for people with some experience of Watercolour.

Watercolour is the most popular medium, and for very good reason. There is little to compare with the beauty of transparent colour washes, watercolours are handled in a way that is impossible with other mediums. This course will have a definite bias towards traditional landscape painting. There will be plenty of new colour mixes, tips and 'tricks of the trade' for you to learn and enjoy.

During the course, the Tutor will encourage you to create paintings from your own observations applying the 'rules' of design and composition.
