The 1 day course will offer an in- depth exploration of a range of techniques both for multiple prints or one-offs. We will cover safe working practices, cutting of lino plates and basic printing techniques. Learners will have the opportunity to print by hand or with a press, producing both colour and black and white.

Learners will explore how to vary effects through inking, varying press pressure, reduction printing and multi plate printing. Aimed at beginners – however suitable for all levels of experience.

Learning aims

1. Apply safe studio practices when cutting
2. Design a range of prints
3. Apply reduction printing method, apply multiple plate method
