

WEAVING ON A 4 SHAFT TABLE LOOM

TUTOR: Anna Crutchley

This course is suitable for beginners, as well as those with previous weaving experience.

Beginners: On this course you will learn to weave on a four-shaft table loom. You will sample a variety of weave structures, with colour combinations, yarn qualities and surface textures, for a range of functions such as rugs, scarves, table runners, trimmings and so on. Looms will be threaded up ready for beginners, and you will also see how to set up a loom from scratch. By the end of the course you will have a comprehensive set of samples and notes, and masses of information to take away and help you continue with your new found craft.

Weavers with previous experience: You are encouraged to discuss your ideas with the tutor in advance so that the course can be tailored to meet your requirements. This could take the form of sampling a new weave structure, developing a new design idea, etc. The course will provide a lively and positive tutorial environment in which new ideas can be explored and developed.

MATERIALS

Materials and equipment will be available on the course, but you are welcome to bring other things you would like to include in the weaving, such as your own yarns, if you have them.

The tutor will supply yarns. The cost of materials will vary according to what you weave, and as a guide, you should expect to spend around £10-20.
